Emma Elvira Beach

Birth Registration fairly clearly shows "Emma Elvira"...yet she repeatedly went by "Emma A" on most census reports I've found. Not sure why.....

The name Emma may have come from Hugh Percy's mother, Emerencianna Frith. I was told that Emerencianna eventually went by Emma.

1900: Living in Antelope, Kimball County, NE

1930: Living in Orenco, WA.

Emma's mother, listed on this census as "Mary E. Beach", was living with her at the time..

Ava Sarah Carlyle

George Douglas & Ava Carlyle Garratt are both buried in Williamette National Cemetery. Both were listed as "CPL, United States Army".
