Margaret Beach

I am guessing her name is Margaret. The census merely shows "M". However, William named two other daughters after his siblings Frances and Amelia. It stands to reason the third was so named.

H P Beach

Hugh Percy Beach lists his father's birthplace as Wales....his mother's as England.

The 1900 Plattsmouth, Cass County, Nebraska, census shows H.P. Beach. The census was taken 5Jun1900, so he died sometime between Jun 5 and Dec 31, 1900.

From Marcia Beach Ditter, daughter of William Hugh Beach:

The family farmed in (Ashton, Osceola County) Michigan and Nebraska; however, crops did not produce enough to support them, so Great-Grandfather Beach (Hugh Percy Beach) went to Fresno, California. There he worked in the coal mines and, within one year, contracted malaria and diabetes and was forced to return home, a hopeless invalid.

Hugh Percy registered to vote in Fresno, California, in 1894. That is probably the year he was working in the coal mines.
