Recently ancestry.com announced the availability of their new graphics options. Literally thousands of genealogists, both hobby and professional, can now post pictures of their respective families. While trying to update my Pollard database for some of our newest "cousins", I stumbled onto this picture of Joseph P. & Mary Elizabeth Pollard Reed.

Mary Elizabeth Pollard was the 3rd child born to Joseph G & Mary Gilstrap Pollard. She was two years older than Isaac G. Pollard, and she is the 2nd Great Grand Aunt to my generation of the Pollard clan. Her children are our 1st. cousins 3X removed.

Mary Elizabeth Pollard was born 22 Mar 1846, in Hudson, Macon County, Missouri. She died on 3 Jun 1931, in Vamoosa, Seminole County, Oklahoma. The caption below the picture, as posted to the ancestry.com web site, gives the following information:

At the time of this discovery, my data showed a William (b 1871) and a Mary Elizabeth (b 1878), but no Walter, Bertram, John, or Daisy. The 1900 Scott County, AR, Census (below right) shows a widowed Mary E. Reed with four of her children.

Her 1931 obituary stated there were six surviving children, four of whom were listed on the 1900 census:

- *W.O. Reed: Walter O. (b Apr 1882)*
- *Bert Reed: Bertram W. (b Jan 1885)*
- *J.P. Reed: John Parlton (b Jan 1888)*
- *Mrs. Holleman: Frank Joiner & Daisy P. Reed Holleman (b Jul 1890)*

The remaining two children listed in the obituary are:

W.C. Reed: William C. (b 1871)

Mrs. Barker: John Vander & Mary Elizabeth Emiline Reed Barker (b 1878)

Subsequent research has turned up some details not available earlier:

Surviving Mrs Reed are 6 children,
W.C. Reed of Mena ARK.
W.O. Reed of Stratford
Bert Reed and J.P. Reed of Konowa
Mrs Barker, of Sasakwa
Mrs Halleman of Vamoosa.

- Cordelia C. Reed (b 1869) is top row left.
- William C. Reed (b 1871) is the young man top right.
- Mary Edna Elizabeth Emiline Reed (b 1878) bottom row left.
- Isaac Reed (b 1879) bottom row right.


One family historian I located states that Mary Elizabeth Emiline Reed Barker was actually Mary Edna Elizabeth Emiline Reed Barker.

So the girl front left is Mary Elizabeth Emiline Reed. (*I don't normally assimilate data from unknown sources, but this data was compiled by a "Barker", so it lends credibility.*)

The picture was apparently taken somewhere around 1879-80 (Isaac looks about one at the time), Walter O. (b Apr 1882), Bertram W. (b Jan 1885), John Parltan (b Jan 1888), Daisy P. (b Jul 1890), were born after the picture was taken. (Mary Elizabeth's nephew, Isaac G. Pollard, had a picture taken about the same time [below].)

Joseph Polk Reed died 18 Feb 1899.
